



Star Toe Worksheet

To use this worksheet, you will need a copy of “Toe-Up! Patterns and Worksheets for Whipping Your Sock Knitting Into Shape” by Chrissy Gardiner. Complete instructions as to how to use the worksheet can be found on p. 33-34.

To Work:

Cast on six stitches, three on each of two circulars or dpns, leaving a 16” tail. Knit each stitch with both the working yarn and the tail, ending with 12 loops on the needles. Each of these loops will be knitted as a separate stitch on the first round of the toe.

If working on dpns, divide these stitches evenly across four dpns with three stitches on each needle. If working on circulars, place a marker in the center of each needle, dividing the stitches into groups of three.

Round 1: Knit.

Round 2: *K-fb, k2; repeat from * to end of round. 16 stitches.

Round 3: Knit.

Round 4: *K-fb, knit to marker; repeat from * to end of round. Four stitches increased.

Repeat Rounds 3 - 4 an additional $(C - 1)$ _____ times. There are now $[(C \times 4) + 16]$ _____ stitches on the needles. Knit one round even.

If D is not 0, work one more increase round, spacing the leftover increases as follows:

- **1 leftover increase:** Place increase after 2nd or 4th marker.
- **2 leftover increases:** Place increases after 1st and 3rd markers.
- **3 leftover increases:** Place increases after 1st, 2nd and 3rd markers or 1st, 3rd and 4th markers.
